PRIVACY POLICY**

Coolidge, Wall, Womsley & Lombard Co., L. P. A. ("CWWL") is committed to protecting the information shared with the firm. This Privacy Policy explains the type of information collected by CWWL, how it is used, and how it is protected. CWWL may occasionally update this Privacy Policy as necessary to maintain the highest protection for its users and clients and to comply with a changing environment. Collection and Tracking of Personal Information

CWWL collects personally identifiable information such as names, e-mail addresses and demographic information such as addresses and phone numbers. CWWL retains records relating to professional services so that it is better able to assist its clients with their professional needs, and in some cases, to comply with professional guidelines.

CWWL uses also uses personal information to understand its users' needs and wants. All of the information entered on this site or e-mailed to CWWL is logged, stored, maintained and retrievable. CWWL uses personal information to send newsletters, emails, features, surveys, and other legal updates to its users. CWWL also uses collected information to evaluate and administer its services, to respond to any problems that may arise, and to measure user trends to determine what part of its services are most popular with users.
